LOADING MACHINE



- Fan material thoroughly before loading into machine. This helps to aerate and separate sheets that have been compacted during the packaging and shipping process.

PRINTING



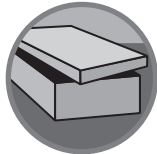
- DuraCopy can be printed on both sides in color as well as black and white.
- Special attention should be taken when duplexing this material. Synthetic materials retain heat longer than normal paper. Excess heat buildup could potentially cause wrinkling or blocking of the sheets. Some copiers have a media setting that can be changed to film or transparency, which may assist in preventing these problems. Another alternative is to print one side at a time, allowing the sheets to cool and then fan material between runs.
- Compatible with most conventional photocopier and laser printers.
- Not for use in ink jet printers. (Instead, use our waterproof WeatherJet)
- If you are having problems writing with a pen, some copiers utilize a fuser oil to help transfer the toner. This slick oil can interfere with the write-ability of a ballpoint pen. Try another printer or simply use a pencil.

RECYCLABLE



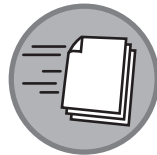
- Recycle DuraCopy with general bulk plastics.

SHELF LIFE



- To insure a quality product always ready to print, keep it in the original packaging.
- Exposure to moisture & humidity prior to printing can compromise the print quality.

PRODUCT PERFORMANCE



- DuraCopy is an extremely durable synthetic waterproof sheet that resists tearing and provides a high quality printing surface.
- DuraCopy works well with any standard pencil or an all-weather pen.
- Proper ink adhesion is a function of correct fuser temperature.
- For best performance select a feed tray on your copier with the straightest paper path.
- DuraCopy can be perforated or hole punched like standard paper.
